



Georgia Virtual School AP[®] Practice Exams

Registration Directions & Frequently Asked Questions

Beginning March 1st, students may register to access AP[®] practice exams.

Students who do **NOT** already have an account with Georgia Virtual School must first complete the steps outlined in Section 1.

Students who **DO*** have an account with Georgia Virtual School should follow the steps outlined in Section 2.

*Students enrolled in a GAVS course during the spring semester do not need to register. The practice exams will be made available to them through their GAVS course. Students who took the AB course during the fall semester may register for the AP[®] practice exam.

SECTION 1

Go to: <http://gavirtuelschool.org>

Click on the **Registration** link at the top of the screen.

Click on the **Create a GAVS Account** link.

Click on the **Create an Account** button.

Complete the online form.

Once your account has been created you may register for courses by following the steps outlined in Section 2.

SECTION 2

Go to: <http://gavirtuelschool.org>

Locate the Login box and click on the **GAVS Students** link.

Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the link, **Enrolling in an AP Practice Course**.

Available AP Practice Exams are listed at the bottom of the page. Click on the **radio button** at the left of the course name and then click the **Apply** button. Repeat the steps listed above to register for more than one practice exam.

It will take up to 48 hours to gain access to your AP[®] practice exam(s). To access the exam(s), go to: <http://gavirtuelschool.org>, login and click on the **MyD2L** link located at the top of the screen.

Access will expire on May 30th.

Q: What practice exams are available?

A: Below is a list of practice exams that are currently available.

Q: Are teachers able to access the AP® practice exams?

A: Regretfully teachers cannot create logins to access the AP® practice exams. There are a very limited number of spaces and we have reserved all of these for student use. However, students are free to show teachers the resources they are using in their practice exams.

Q: How long will students have to access the AP® practice exams?

A: Students will be able to register/access the AP® practice exams from March 1st through May 30th. After registering, students will need to wait 24-48 hours to gain access to their practice exam(s).

Q: Do all of the resources need to be used in one sitting?

A: No. Students will have access to all features of the practice exam through May 30th. Students may take the practice exams more than one time. Each time a student takes a section of the practice exam, the questions and answer choices will be randomly shuffled to a new order.

Q: What is the format of the AP® practice exams?

A: The questions in the AP® practice exams were written by Georgia AP® teachers in the same style and format as those found on the real AP® exams. Each exam has a multiple choice and free-response section set to the actual time allowed by the College Board. Students receive feedback on the questions and may take the practice exams as many times as they wish. Additionally, the practice exams have flashcards that students can use to practice key vocabulary terms as well as hints and strategies for tackling the multiple choice and free response sections.

Q: Will students receive a grade or score on the AP® practice exams?

A: Students will learn which questions they answered correctly and which ones they missed. Each question has detailed feedback to help students understand why the right answer choice is correct. Students will see a percentage of the questions they answered correctly but their score is not calculated to account for the ¼ point penalty assessed by College Board for wrong answers.
